receive an appointment beginning at 8:30 AM. **SABER** (Substance Abuse Education and Self Recovery) Information: Director Marilyn Furman brought the model from the University of Alabama at Birmingham, based upon their addiction research. **SABER** combines nine months of therapy and life-changing skills with the guarantee of free housing, as long as the person stays drug and alcohol-free. This expectation helps the program achieve a 55% success rate after nine

months, compared with a national average of 20% for other substance programs. In

addition, 85% complete SABER's three-month intensive treatment. And there's another important difference: SABER costs \$500 per person per month, compared with an average of \$2,300 per month for typical residential care.
